

**Remote Replacement for Honor**



1. Remove the 4 screws holding the rear panel.
2. Slide rear panel downwards slightly and pull back.

**3. Locate and cut the 2 zip ties holding the remote wire**



**4. Unscrew the remote wire holder**



5. Twist the cap holding the remote wire to the connector.
6. Seperate the remote wire and remote connector.



**7. Separate the shoulder airbag and the backpad to pull the remote cord.**



8. Pull remote wire from gap




9. Push new remote wire into same gap.



- 10. Connect new remote wire to wire connector.**  
**11. Zip tie (preferred) to bar which wire previously was zip tied to.**



12. Put the rear panel back into place. Make sure the two plastic bars on the rear panel slide underneath the grooves on the chair.



**13. Slide rear panel slightly upwards to secure back into place.**  
**14. Screw the 4 rear panel screws back in. Make sure the top two holes are lined up properly (they're easier to see than the bottom two).**
